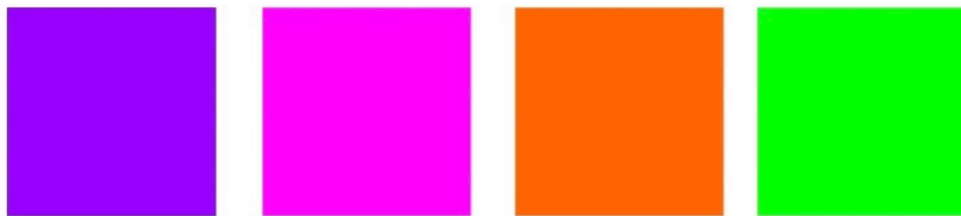
Lock	Combination	Create Puzzle	Solution
<p>5 Letter Lock</p> <p>Alternative Option: Print the poem from this download. The letters WROTE are all improperly capitalized throughout the poem.</p>	<p>WROTE</p> <p>Down in the hollow, Not so far away, I saw a little lady bug When I went to play</p> <p>Swinging on the clover Up in the air... I wonder if the ladybug Knew I was there.</p>	<p>Poem written in pencil except for the letters that spell out 'wrote'. Write these 5 letters in pen. Place an eraser in the area with the poem.</p> <p>I used the poem Down in the Hollow by Aileen Fisher.</p>	<p>Looking at the poem they will notice the letters W R O T E are written in ink instead of pencil.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Or</p> <p>They can use the eraser to erase the poem leaving them with with the letters to spell wrote.</p>
Key Lock		<p>Create a baking soda ball, using a thick paste made from baking soda and water. (Add color to this paste for added effect!) Place the key in the center. I froze my ball overnight.</p> <p>Place the ball in a deep baking dish with a cup of white vinegar near by.</p>	They pour the white vinegar over the ball to create a volcano like reaction and find the key inside.
4 Digit Lock	5-2-4-6	<p>Gather a bunch of dice. Use any type of dice you have. On separate dice tape a purple paper over the 5, a pink paper over the 2, orange paper over the 4, and green paper over the 6.</p> <p>Print & cut out the clue paper below to set near a container of dice.</p>	They write the numbers under the colored papers on the dice onto the coordinating box of color on the clue sheet.
4 Digit Lock	9-8-3-1	Print or write the numbers and clue. Place one in each balloon. Blow up the balloon. Decorate the lock box site.	After popping the balloons they will discover the numbers and follow the clue.
3 Digit Lock	2-9-3	Using an older calendar place stickers over numbers 2, 9, and 3 (In chronological order)	They realize the numbers which are covered are the numbers for the 3 digit lock.
Directional Lock	W-S-E-W-N-E	On 6 Craft Sticks write 1-6 and the direction on each one. Or print and cut the strips of paper in the download and place around the lockbox area.	I also taped a North, East, South, West onto my directional lock.

When I went to play.

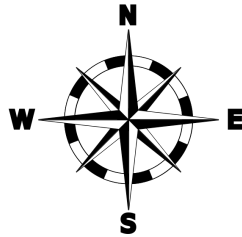
Swinging on the clOver
